

## Academic Scholarship Guidelines

The Law Librarians of New England (LLNE) would like to support its members in their law librarianship career path. To help in achieving this goal, the Executive Board has authorized the granting of one or two academic scholarships of \$500 each year. **Applicants must be an active or student member of LLNE** to be eligible and each individual will be limited to one academic scholarship award. Current Scholarship Committee members are ineligible to receive awards during their tenure.

Candidates must be enrolled in an accredited degree program in Library Science or in an ABA accredited law school to be eligible. Preference will be given to candidates who are taking or have taken a course in Legal Bibliography, Law Librarianship, or Advanced Legal Research.

Applications will be reviewed each year in September. Scholarship awards will be announced in October. Successful applicants will be required to provide proof of enrollment in an accredited degree program. Applicants selected for an academic scholarship will be required to write a brief article for the LLNE News and/or a post for the LLNE blog about their path to law librarianship and the impact of their scholarship award.
